AN ORDINANCE DECLARING SALAKOT LOCATED AT THE BAYANIHAN PARK, AS ONE OF THE IMPORTANT HISTORICAL STRUCTURES IN ANGELES CITY.

Introduced by Councilors Maricel G. Morales and Arvin M. Suller

Whereas, Section 2 of RA 10066, “AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PROTECTION AND CONSERVATION OF THE NATIONAL CULTURAL HERITAGE, STRENGTHENING THE NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR CULTURE AND THE ARTS (NCCA) AND ITS AFFILIATED CULTURAL AGENCIES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES” states: “Sections 14, 15, 16, and 17, Article XIV of the 1987 Constitution declare that the State shall foster the preservation, enrichment, and dynamic evolution of a Filipino culture based on the principle of unity in diversity in a climate of free artistic and intellectual expression. The Constitution likewise mandates the State to conserve, develop, promote and popularize the nation’s historical and cultural heritage and resources, as well as artistic creations. It further provides that, all the country’s artistic and historic wealth constitutes the cultural treasure of the nation and shall be under the protection of the State, which may regulate its disposition.”

Whereas, “Salakot” is a symbol of getting free from the clutches of the American dominion in Angeles City;

Whereas, The US Military Bases Agreement was forged between the United States of America and the Government of the Republic of the Philippines in 1947, a 99-year period treaty which was cut short during the time of President Ferdinand E. Marcos in 1979;

Whereas, for the first time the flag of the United States of America was hailed down and the Philippine flag, the symbol of our jurisdiction and authority was raised, concomitant to that was the establishment of the “Salakot”;

Whereas, the popularly known “Salakot” was originally located at the entrance of the Clark Air Base, is a silent witness of the resiliency of the Kapampangans and Angelenos during the withdrawal of the Americans from Clark Air Base and still standing even after the onslaught of the eruption of Mt. Pinatubo in the early nineties.

Whereas, Clark Development Corporation, SM Clark and the City of Angeles jointly relocated the Salakot inside the Bahanihan Park, with the same artistry and preserved its tangible and intangible historical value;

Whereas, the “Salakot” has been an iconic edifice in the City of Angeles, being a symbol of pride by the Angelenos, with its figurative existence, will make each feel his presence in the City of Angeles;

Now Therefore, Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Angeles in session assembled, that:

Section 1. The “Salakot” located at the Bahanihan Park, be declared as one of the important historical structures in Angeles City.

Section 2. That a buffer zone of 50 meters around the area, subject to the provisions of RA 10066 “National Cultural Heritage Act of 2009”, the BCDA Law, the CDC Law and other measures shall be strictly enforced.


Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.




